**16.06.1970** Opening as FDGB holiday home "Adolf Deter"

**October 1993** Start of renovation and new construction by the Sölzer family

**18.06.1994** Opening of the 4-star hotel "Der Berghof"  
Since then, a conference and holiday hotel with 102 rooms.

**Autumn 2001** Lease by the Rudolph family and renaming to "Waldhotel Berghof"

**Summer 2008** Purchase of the house by the Rodolph family

**2012** New construction of the pool with wellness area, sauna and steam bath

## Luisenthal – A Piece of History

Nestled in the forests of Thuringia, at an altitude of 450 to 730 meters above sea level, lies the picturesque village of Luisenthal in the approximately 4 km long forest valley between Kienberg (723 m), Steinigenberg (596 m), and Streitberg (698 m). Luisenthal consists of three districts: Luisenthal (in the north), Stutzhaus (village center), and Schwarzwald (in the south, around the castle). The largest and oldest district is Schwarzwald. The settlement was already mentioned in 919. Duke Frederick III of Saxe-Gotha-Altenburg acquired in 1752 an ironworks located south of Ohrdruf at the foot of the Kienberg, called the 'Schwarzwälder Hammer'. Later, this became the Stutzhaus ironworks. The Duke then named the settlement in honor of his wife, Duchess Luise Dorothea, 'Luisenthaler Hütte'. The forest workers' settlement Stutzhaus was established in the 17th century on the banks of the Ohra.

In 1952, the three previously independent municipalities were merged as part of a territorial reform and have since been called Luisenthal.

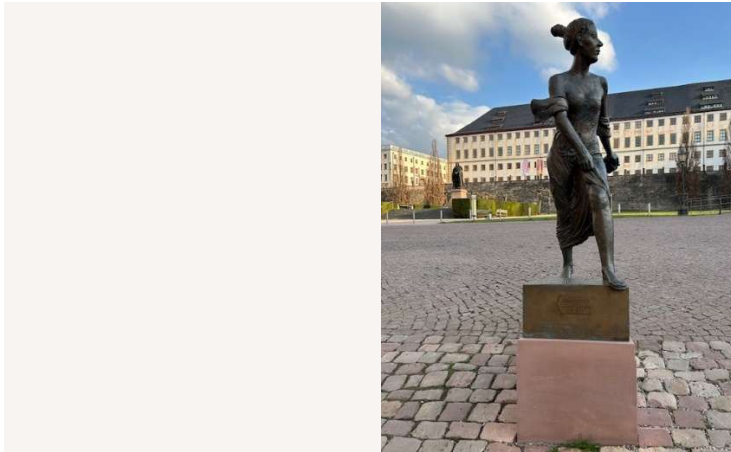
For the Ohratal Dam, large parts of the Schwarzwald settlement as well as industrial facilities, including the iron hammer, were demolished and flooded.

The dam of the reservoir is a 56-meter-high embankment dam with a 260 meter-long dam wall. It provides about 700,000 people with the best drinking water, covers 82 hectares, and holds about 18 million cubic meters of water.

The depth is about 58 meters. Since it is a purely drinking water reservoir, there is a strict ban on bathing and entering.

## **Excursions we recommend:**

- ⊞ **Circular hiking trail around the Ohra Dam, from the hotel 19.4 km**
- ⊞ **Past the war memorial and the old Zimmertal rampart, possibly with a small detour to the blue bench, you will reach the Schwarzwald castle ruins, called Käfernburg, in about 45 minutes. The view is worth the climb.**
- ⊞ **Residential city of Gotha, beautiful city center with Friedenstein Castle. Here you will find traces of Luise Dorothea...**
